

## "HANK PARKER, JR. RACES TO 12<sup>TH</sup> PLACE FINISH IN MEMPHIS"

MOORESVILLE, NC (June 21, 2004) Hank Parker, Jr. came to Memphis looking to have a solid run while keeping the nose of his No. 21 Toyota Tundra clean. He did just that after starting 16<sup>th</sup> and finishing 12<sup>th</sup>.

Hank ran in the top-20 most of the day and rather than move trucks out of the way he chose the high road to cleanly pick up positions on the track. "There was a lot of beating and banging going on out there today and I could have made up some time by moving people out of the way, but that's not how I race. I was really strong coming out of turn two, and I was able to make up ground there." said Parker, Jr. He continued, "Wesley Sherrill (crew chief) and the crew gave me a real hot rod today and the truck was as good as it's been all year. I'm really proud of these guys."

Hank and the No. 21 Toyota Tundra return to the track on June 25, 2004, at the Milwaukee Mile when the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series returns to action in West Allis, WI. Live television coverage will be on Speed Channel, with radio coverage on the MRN Affiliates and XM Satellite Radio.
