## "HANK PARKER, JR., MILWAUKEE MILE PREVIEW"

MOORESVILLE, NC (June 23, 2004) Hank Parker, Jr. and the #21 Innovative Motorsports race team travel to the Milwaukee Mile this Friday for the Black Cat Fireworks 200, race number nine on the Craftsman Truck Series schedule this year.

With five career starts at the one-mile, paperclip shaped track, Parker, Jr. hopes to continue to build on his current track resume. In four Busch Series starts and one Craftsman Truck Series start, Parker, Jr. has two top 10 starts and finishes. One year ago, Parker Jr. made his NCTS debut in Milwaukee starting ninth and finishing eighth.

"We've had some problems this year, but we're getting better every race," says Parker, Jr. "My team has stuck by me and Toyota has stood behind me. They've both worked real hard to try to make things better and make me more comfortable in the Tundra." He continued, "I am really excited about going to Milwaukee. I'm ready to get back out on the track."

Hank and the No. 21 Toyota Tundra return to the track on June 25, 2004, at the Milwaukee Mile when the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series returns to action in West Allis, WI. Live television coverage will be on Speed Channel, with radio coverage on the MRN Affiliates and XM Satellite Radio.
